



Garboldisham C v Diss B – 30 April 2011

Diss Cricket Club's new men's third team played in their first competitive fixture in the Norfolk League at Garboldisham's new fourth team. Diss batted first and their innings received a positive start from their captain Doug Young, who scored 51 in quick time before falling lbw to Garboldisham captain Rogers. The innings was given further impetus by Mark Brawn, who scored 70. With a final cameo of 22 from Spencer Davy, the Diss innings reached 211 for 7 from their 45 overs.

Ling picked up three wickets, Rogers two and Lydia Raven bowled well for her two wickets.

Garboldisham lost two quick wickets at the start of their innings leaving them at 22 for 2. However, opener Fidler and number four Duncanson put on a large partnership of 132 both batting comfortably. Liam Fairweather's eight overs of left-arm spin helped slow the run-rate until Kieran Pask had Fidler lbw for 87. Diss bowlers then fought back having Duncanson bowled for a well-crafted 62 by Lewis Brawn.

Wickets then fell at regular intervals leaving Garboldisham all out for 190 and Diss victors by 21 runs.
